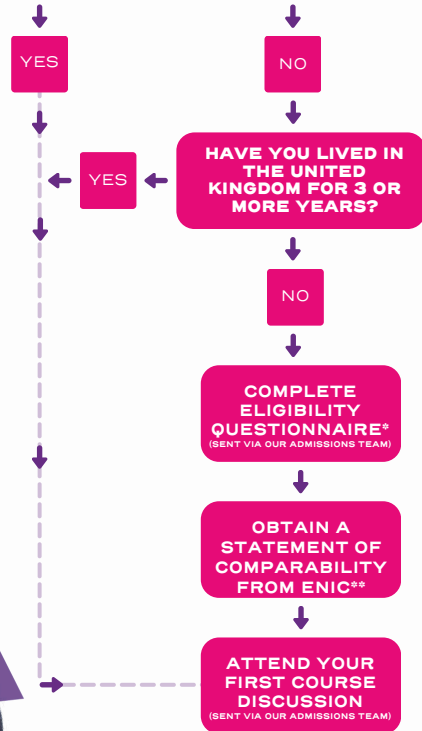

**ENIC STATEMENT OF COMPARABILITY REQUIRED

If you have foreign qualifications equivalent to GCSE and above, you must convert these qualifications into an English equivalent, to check your prior learning and suitability for your course before starting studies at our college in September. This conversion involves obtaining a statement of comparability from ENIC (European Network of Information Centres). This official document evaluates and compares academic qualifications earned outside of the UK with the standards of the British education system. This will ensure you are placed on a programme of study best suited to your academic achievements. It is strongly advised to initiate this process as soon as possible as we need to see your statement of comparability at enrolment. You can commence your application for a statement of comparability [HERE](#).

Once you have received you must email your ENIC statement of comparability to admissions@stokesfc.ac.uk by mid August at the latest, noting your full name, student ID number or date of birth. Failure to provide this information may delay or result in the rejection of your application to study at the college.

*ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS REQUESTED

If applicable, please provide your Share Code for UK Immigration this is a unique share code or reference number assigned by UK Immigration authorities. This code will enable us to access your immigration status electronically and verify your eligibility for enrolment. If you are not able to provide a Share Code for UK Immigration, you MUST provide at least ONE of the alternative documentations listed below:

- UK passport or endorsed passport from your country of origin.
- Valid visa or immigration status permitting study in the UK e.g. Tier 4 (General) student visa, Student Route visa, or any other relevant visa category.
- Biometric Residency Permit (BRP) or other official residence permit indicating permission to stay and study in the UK.
- Confirmation of Settled or Pre-Settled Status under the EU Settlement Scheme, for EU, EEA, or Swiss citizens.
- Any other relevant immigration documentation issued by UK Visas and Immigration (UKVI) or Home Office
